The number of fraud cases is increasing!

Scammers may call and pretend to be police officers to make claims such as "You are suspected of a crime" or "Pay money to avoid being arrested."

If you do as the scammer says, your assets will be taken by the scammer.

## $\sim$ Tips to avoid being scammed $\sim$

- 1. When you are told over the phone to "prepare money and send it" on phone or you are asked to contact someone on an app, suspect that it is FRAUD!
- 2. When you are asked for MONEY, immediately cut off contact and consult with your family members, friends and the police!
