\star Manners and rules in Japan

O Noise complaints

Avoid making loud noises when you invite your friends to your house and don't turn the volume of TV and music too high. It may bother your neighbors.

O Garbage disposal

Please sort your garbage into combustible or plastic and dispose it on designated day at designated area. Do not take home garbage disposed by others since it might contain recyclable materials.

Acts which are regarded as a crime in Japan

-- Be aware of illegal part time jobs offered through social media or by your acquaintances

O Giving your cash card to others

If you give your cash card, bank book, or smartphone to others, it might be used in crimes.

Don't give them to others even if you are promised cash payment in return.

It is illegal to give them even to your friends or acquaintances, even if you don't receive payment in return.

Close your bank accounts when you leave Japan.

• Making a bank account book which is not for your own use

It is a crime to make a bank account or enter into mobile phone contract with the intent of selling them to others.

Don't do it.

Illegal gambling

Some forms of gambling are illegal. Engaging in illegal gambling might lead to money troubles that cause serious incidents which result in bodily injuries. Don't do it.
